OUR CHARITABLE PURPOSE

The charitable purpose of EYPUK is to **inspire and empower** a young generation of informed, open-minded, responsible, and active citizens to **shape society and drive impact**. This purpose serves three benefits:

LEVELLING THE EDUCATIONAL PLAYING FIELD.

Through specific **outreach** events as well as our targeting of **underrepresented regions** and **state** schools, we enhance the educational opportunities of around 1000 students in the UK each year.

IMPROVING EMPLOYMENT PROSPECTS FOR YOUNG PEOPLE.

The skills learned through engaging with our events are **transferable** and will benefit students, no matter what career they enter. Our focus on **non-formal education** and skills provisions helps to bridge the gap between education and employment.



INCREASING POLITICAL ENGAGEMENT OF YOUNG PEOPLE

Young people have the lowest engagement rate with the political system and often feel ignored by it. EYPUK gives them a place to **use their political voice.**

EYPUK delivers its mission through events which bring young people aged 16-24 together to find **potential solutions** to the **biggest challenges currently facing the UK and Europe**. The experience of researching the problem individually, discussing and presenting the solutions as a team, and then debating it with the wider community provides a **rich**, **engaging experience**. The values which **define** the experience are:

CHALLENGING AND AMBITIOUS:

Young people at our events discuss **complex real-world issues** outside of the school curriculum. They use consensus-based decision making to come up with solutions which are of an **extremely high academic standard**. It is often an **empowering process** for participants to participate in.

INNOVATIVE:

Participants are encouraged to think outside the box to come up with **new** and innovative solutions to problems. Events are usually focused on a central theme which aims to encourage this. Past themes have included such as sustainability or digitalisation.

A LEVEL PLAYING FIELD:

We believe that every young person should have the opportunity to be inspired by and engage with current affairs, regardless of their socioeconomic status. We work with schools to provide outreach opportunities for young people who may not otherwise have access to these types of experiences. In the future, we aspire to provide travel grants and subsidised participation costs to young people who would not otherwise be able to afford participation.



EVENTS

REGIONAL

Every year, EYPUK hosts approximately 13 regional events across the country in February and March. These events provide an opportunity for school teams to debate and suggest solutions to some of the most pressing issues facing the UK and Europe. Most of these events are one day in length. We are also currently expanding our regional program and now offer extended sessions in Newcastle and Merseyside. During these extended sessions, participants have the opportunity to not only discuss issues, but also spend time writing and developing solutions to them. We believe that this added focus on solution-building can help empower our attendees to take on leadership roles and make a positive impact in their communities and beyond.





NATIONAL & INTERNATIONAL



Twice a year, EYPUK hosts **national events** in Liverpool that are three days in length for the schools who have been successful at regionals. These events provide an opportunity for attendees to engage with current affairs and empower them to think outside the box. During the events, attendees participate in team building activities, work as a team to write a resolution to an issue which they have chosen, and then take part in a general assembly where they discuss and vote on the ideas. Participants are judged based on **teamwork**, **participation**, **ambassadorial qualities**, **development and preparation**. Those who are successful then have the opportunity to participate in an **international session**, which could be anywhere in Europe –from Tromso, to Milan, to Riga. These are **once in a lifetime experiences** for participants and provide amazing opportunities for **cross-cultural exchange**.



OUTREACH



Our outreach programme **EurVoice** is a unique **community outreach program** that allows students of all ages and backgrounds to engage with the local and national issues that matter most to young people. They are **free**, one-day events that take place in a 'Question Time' style panel with politicians and local community figures, and happen across the year in cities around the UK.

TRAINING

EYPUK has a developed training programme which involves hosting our **annual training weekend** for all members of varying levels of experience, providing training both related to working with young people, as well as gaining **professional skills**. We send representatives every year to a European-wide training event to **collaborate** with other charities and share best practices, as well as sending our more experienced trainers to a European-wide 'training for trainers' workshop to ensure the knowledge we are passing on is **up-to-date and relevant** to the needs of our members.







Grants to widen participation:

Your financial contribution will help us cover the costs of running our conferences and provide **travel and fee grants** for attendees who may not otherwise be able to afford to participate. By providing these types of grants, we hope to **level the playing field** and ensure that all young people have the opportunity to participate in our conferences and events. We are grateful for financial contributions that support these grants and help us make our events more accessible to young people from all backgrounds. Currently, our participation costs are around £200 per person for our five-day conference, meaning a **grant of £2,000** could enable a school group from a **less economically-privileged region** to attend free of charge.

Committee sponsor:

All of EYPUK's events discuss a range of topical current affairs. Some past topics include statelessness, the impact of automation on employment, gender bias within technology, migration, trade relations, regional minority languages, and much more. By **sponsoring a topic**, you could decide which topic a group of around 15 people work on finding solutions to, which is later debated to an audience of 150 people. This is a great way to get young people thinking about and discussing topics **close to your organisation's heart**. You can even send a **representative to speak to the committee** either in-person or digitally, giving you **direct access to a group of engaged and active young people.**



In-Kind Donations:

Do you have a product or service that you think our attendees would benefit from? We welcome **in-kind donations** as they can help us provide a better experience for our attendees and reduce our costs.
