

Explanation of EYPUK Membership



Membership Policy

In May 2020, EYPUK adopted the following new membership policy (effective immediately).

A Member of EYPUK gains membership in the following ways:

A) An individual, who has no previous affiliation with another National Committee, may complete the application form and, if successful, pay a one-off £5 registration subscription. The application is reviewed by a selection committee and the candidate will be informed of its success or failure within 30 days of submission.

B) An individual attends a multiday EYPUK session as a delegate and both the application form and £5 registration fee is automatically waived. This is only open to those considered UK for the purpose of International Session selection and not to international delegations or officials attending EYPUK sessions.

Adjudication of Membership Application

This is only relevant for Option A) of membership. For 2020, applications will be reviewed on a case by case basis by a selection committee made up of the Chair and two Vice Chairs from the Board of Trustees and the President of the Alumni Executive Committee. The minimum age of successful applicants is 16 and the maximum age is 25.

Electorate and Eligibility for Committee

Voting and standing in the EYPUK Executive Committee elections is only open to members who have attended an EYPUK multiday session in the past two years, as either a delegate or official, or, failing this, became members through Option A) within the past two years. The same rules apply for those invited to join the Board of Trustees.
